Proposal: Listed Building Consent: Fixing of Blue Plaque commemorating the founders of the Poly, the Fox sisters.

Remit:

The Theatres Trust is the national advisory public body for theatres. We were established through the Theatres Trust Act 1976 'to promote the better protection of theatres' and provide statutory planning advice on theatre buildings and theatre use in England through The Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015, requiring the Trust to be consulted by local authorities on planning applications which include 'development involving any land on which there is a theatre'.

Comment:

This application has come to the Trust's attention as it relates to a theatre, known as 'The Poly'.

The proposal seeks to install a blue plaque on the front (east) elevation of the building which commemorates the founders of The Poly. We do not consider the plaque to detract from the character and appearance of the building as a Grade II* asset of significant heritage value for Falmouth, and actually creates a new point on interest within the town. Neither will it have any detrimental impact on the function of the building.

We therefore **support** this proposal and **recommend the granting of listed building consent**.
