Proposals: Listed building application for the installation of one CCTV camera

Remit:

The Theatres Trust is the national advisory public body for theatres. We were established through the Theatres Trust Act 1976 'to promote the better protection of theatres' and provide statutory planning advice on theatre buildings and theatre use in England through The Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015, requiring the Trust to be consulted by local authorities on planning applications which include 'development involving any land on which there is a theatre'.

Comment:

This proposal seeks the addition of a CCTV camera to help improve the safety and security of staff and other visitors to the theatre. The camera is of modest size and scale for which there will be only minor impact on the visual appearance of the building. We **recommend the granting of listed building consent.**
