Proposal: Advertisement consent for replacement of the existing theatre building signage with an LED information screen and installation of new larger lilluminated signage at high level.

Remit:

The Theatres Trust is the national advisory public body for theatres. We were established through the Theatres Trust Act 1976 'to promote the better protection of theatres' and provide statutory planning advice on theatre buildings and theatre use in England through The Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015, requiring the Trust to be consulted by local authorities on planning applications which include 'development involving any land on which there is a theatre'.

Comment:

This application has been brought to the Trust's attention as it relates to a proposal for new signage at the Milton Keynes Theatre.

The existing theatre sign currently placed above the entrance canopy is to be removed and will instead sit at a higher level in larger font with changing colours. This will enhance the prominence and profile of the theatre.

In place of the previous sign will be a digital information board, with new six new LCD poster boards to be displayed either side of the main entrance. We are supportive of these new display boards, which will help promote upcoming events at the theatre and generally give better activation to Margaret Powell Square. Advertisements and show signage are in any case an integral aspect of the character and appearance of theatre buildings.
