Proposal: Proposed new opening through balustrade and addition of three steps to provide access to box.

Remit:

The Theatres Trust is the national advisory public body for theatres. We were established through the Theatres Trust Act 1976 'to promote the better protection of theatres' and provide statutory planning advice on theatre buildings and theatre use in England through The Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015, requiring the Trust to be consulted by local authorities on planning applications which include 'development involving any land on which there is a theatre'.

Comment:

Thank you for consulting the Theatres Trust on the above application for listed building consent at Duchess Theatre. The theatre is a Grade II listed heritage asset; this proposal seeks to provide additional access to the stage right box by opening through a balustrade to the rear of the Dress Circle and removing two seats.

The opening through the balustrade will replicate the existing opening to the 'stage left' box opposite. It will make the box more accessible and reduce the demand on staff who currently have to lead ticketholders to their seats via the staircase behind through a staff area.

We would concur with the applicant's Heritage Statement which states the balustrade has no decorative or architectural significance. The new opening and removal of the seats will result in greater symmetry in appearance for the Dress Circle. Although two seats will be lost it will
