Proposal: Listed Building Consent for renovation of disused public toilets in basement to include creation of two new openings to access existing passageway adjacent to bar, install lintels above openings, block up old external door, repair all walls and floor and new stud walls to form cubicles

Remit:

The Theatres Trust is the national advisory public body for theatres. We were established through the Theatres Trust Act 1976 'to promote the better protection of theatres' and provide statutory planning advice on theatre buildings and theatre use in England through The Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015, requiring the Trust to be consulted by local authorities on planning applications which include 'development involving any land on which there is a theatre'.

Comment:

Thank you for re-consulting Theatres Trust regarding this application following submission of additional documents. We previously submitted comments supporting the project and the principle of listed building consent but noted a lack of information had been provided including no proposed plans. A proposed basement plan and plan focussed on the WC area has now been provided along with a slightly amended Heritage Statement and Design and Access Statement.

The plans show the WCs will be accessed through an existing void and one of the existing WCs through which new openings will be created. There will be alteration to the layout within the WCs which will offset the lost WC and provide one additional compared to what is currently there. The four additional WCs coming into the theatre will offer a substantial uplift in provision which will
