Proposal: Advertising consent for a neon (glass) illuminated 'Curzon' sign

Remit:

Theatres Trust is the national advisory public body for theatres. We were established through the Theatres Trust Act 1976 'to promote the better protection of theatres' and provide statutory planning advice on theatre buildings and theatre use in England through The Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015, requiring the Trust to be consulted by local authorities on planning applications which include 'development involving any land on which there is a theatre'.

Comment:

This application has come to the attention of the Trust because it is seeking advertisement consent at the Curzon in relation to installation of new signage to the building's east elevation.

This application corresponds with a listed building consent which was granted in 2022 and on which we also commented. The addition of the Curzon's 'sunburst' logo helps activate this elevation and increases visibility and prominence. We do not consider that it negatively impacts on highway safety or the amenity of nearby properties. Brightness levels can in any case be managed through condition, and the applicant has previously stated hours of operation will be limited to 10pm. Therefore we are supportive of the granting of advertisement consent.
