We commented on a previous (permitted) application in 2022 which also sought to construct a meeting room in the same location and of similar scale. It appears this was not built out, and this fresh application introduces an alternative design approach with a greater overhang, reduced glazing and different materials.

The Viva Theatre opened in November 2021 following conversion of a disused mill. It has a mixed programme including theatre, a number of comedy shows and workshops. It also offers rehearsal and events space, providing a space for local people to engage and participate in culture and the arts. Paragraph 93 of the NPPF (2023) seeks planning decisions to plan positively for community and cultural facilities.

We welcome continued investment and development of the theatre. The additional facility will enhance the theatre's role and function. We are therefore we are supportive of the granting of planning permission.
